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What is an Elevator Speech?

- An elevator speech is a short, concise discussion of your organization
- It shouldn't be too long
- It should be targeted to the audience that you are talking to



Don't Forget Who You're Talking To... Who Is Your Audience?

- We get too used to talking in a "funder's language"
- Use a language that people who are looking at your website understand.
- Write in normal, every-day vocabulary



Go for the Heart ... Not just the the Head

- Tell a compelling story
- It can be a story about one of your members. Telling their story makes it real and personal
- Tie it to your issues. It can be like your outreach rap – problem and solution
