Review & Understand Your Data

 Scour the fields of data for inconsistencies in values, abbreviations, or misspelled words for which you would need to perform searches

○ e.g. using "Ave." or "Av." or "Avenue"

Do the fields contain appropriate & meaningful data?

Clean Your Data

- Standardize your addresses using USPS Postal Address standards, see Publication 28: http://pe.usps.gov/cpim/itp/pubs/Pub28/pub28.pd
- Make values in fields consistent and meaningful
- Look for fields or data that no longer have any purpose and remove

Prepare data for Import into PowerBase

- Have unique record id's / member #'s for each contact record
- Merge all spreadsheets, databases into one
- Remove duplicate records and consolidate information as necessary (can also be done in PowerBase)

Prepare data (cont'd)

- Recommend list enhancement to get voter id's if appropriate
- Create unique records for EACH individual contact (ah yes, the dreaded household issue!)
 - Split multiple names that exist one record into separate unique records for each name

Prepare data (cont'd)

- Make a list of existing data fields and any new fields you want to track with descriptions
 - ✓ Identify standard values for each field
 - Does field contain a unique value, or multiple values
 - ✓ Is field required?
 - Describe format of the data (e.g. alphanumeric, number, Yes/No)

Practice for KEEPING your Data Clean

- Assign a database administrator who will periodically verify data that has been entered
- Document how data fields are to be used for data entry
- Train all staff in the use of the database
